CGFA has two registered lobbyists on staff and a technical director who play a key role in influencing decision-making in California on behalf of the industry. CGFA is involved in many issues including: agricultural marketing, transportation/trucking, air pollution laws and other environmental regulation, pesticide laws and registration, grain inspection, farm animal welfare and more.

CGFA's environmental staff has experience in underground tank registration and removal, conducting air pollution risk assessments, Air Toxic Hot Spot Reporting, Storm Water Run-Off Regulation & Compliance, Conducting Phase I & II Environmental Audits, SB 198 Injury & Illness Prevention Planning, Hazardous Materials Storage & Handling and more. CGFA operates a Stormwater Monitoring Group program. Participation in the program is available to all members.

The California Grain & Feed Association is a nonprofit agricultural trade association which has served the grain and feed industry since 1924. Although a pioneer, the Association has remained "youthful" in its approach and activities by emphasizing future needs rather than past accomplishments.
