2 main components:


1) Class prices: minimum price processors have to pay based on the products they make

- 5 different classes

  - Commodities: butter, cheese, powder (NFDM) and dry whey


2) Pooling: sharing of revenues from class prices among producers




## Russia ban still in effect

- The U.S. does not export significant volumes of dairy products to Russia

### Chinese imports decline



























#### Milk Production, Top 5 Dairy States

- Number of dairies in gradual decline
  - 2,157 dairies in 2001
  - 1,668 dairies in 2011
  - 1,470 dairies in 2014
  - 1,438 dairies in 2015
  - Which county has the most dairies?

- Cows per dairy continue to increase
  - 721 cows per dairy in 2001
  - 1,101 cows per dairy in 2011
  - 1,217 cows per dairy in 2014
  - 1,215 cows per dairy in 2015
  - What is the county with the highest average?
