You Could Qualify

Awards are made available for students who plan to enroll or are currently enrolled in a 4-year college or university. Upcoming awards will be distributed for the Fall Semester/Quarter of 2026.

Eligibility

Acceptable fields of study include, but are not limited to: agribusiness, production and those with an emphasis on agriculture.

Special interest in the California grain and feed industry is an important component. Sophomore to Senior Undergraduates and Graduate students enrolling or enrolled on a full-time basis in college or universities are eligible.

Criteria

Awards are made on the basis of the following criteria:

- Your affiliation through programs, internships, events and/or tours offered or promoted by the CGFA Foundation. Including the student's present and future interest in the California grain and feed industry.
- Letter of recommendation.
- Scholarship personal letter question.
- Your scholastic achievement and activities.
